

## Neighbourhood Plan Progress Report – PC Meeting July 2016

### Building the Community Evidence Base – Major Focus for month

- a. **Census / ONS data analysis** continued – extracted / tabulated most of the relevant data. Covers the resident population only – but it is universally accepted as being the most reliable dataset for our purposes. Next step is to consider how it can be used to support NP policies (clues from poster exhibition)
- b. **Questionnaire Survey** - Processed by Computer Bureau. We have
  - i. checked coding & validation work – looks really good
  - ii. Populated the questionnaire form with the responses - creation of basic evidence base for analysis and checking

#### *Next steps:*

- iii. Compare basic results to Census data to see if representative
- iv. Carry out the analysis – Tables, Graphs & Pie charts - & possibly some statistical analysis if warranted
- v. Coding & analysis of text responses – comments made by lots of people eg about places & views to protect

## 2. Task 4: Built Environment

- a. Main input from Bob Bowman the architect in our team
- b. Survey of buildings in the Parish: recording main characteristics / features to help develop design criteria as basis for policy / development control
- c. Identification of undesignated assets

## 3. Geographical Information System to support mapping / spatial analysis

- a. Can be integrated with other data sources eg buildings survey – used to produce detailed maps of the village showing individual properties
- b. Can be used to map our heritage assets – designated & undesignated that people have said they want to protect, and hopefully the footpath network
- c. Exploring whether it can be used to identify important views in the Parish eg the Church
