

## **Neighbourhood Plan Progress Report – PC Meeting 9 January 2018**

### **Work in progress November - December/January**

1. Most of the work since mid-November has been focused on completing work on the draft policies and maps plus posters for the Consultation Event.
2. We hosted a day-long visit by Natural England and the Norfolk Coast Partnership at the beginning of December.
3. Natural England have been extremely helpful by producing a Working Paper that combines our background research with their work on the Character Areas and this will provide an important source of evidence for our policies.
4. The Consultation Event on 04 January was very successful and attracted more than 80 visitors – a mixture of parishioners, developers and Councillors from the neighbouring coastal parishes. We were particularly pleased to have the support of Borough Councillor Liz Watson.
5. We received a huge amount of feedback on the draft policies – all of which will be reviewed by the NDP Team.
6. Once we have done this and we have received feedback from the Development Control Team at BCKL&WN we can move on to the task of gathering together the evidence and justification for the policies and combining these into the Draft Plan.
