

NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN UPDATE – JUNE/JULY 2018

1. Work is continuing on compiling the evidence and justification documents to support the proposed policies.
2. Most of the work in the past month has been on the Heritage Report which draws upon a very large number of sources. This is important to support both the Heritage and Conservation policies in the Plan.
3. Following the recent meeting with the Assistant Director of Planning we have been looking into ways of incorporating some guidance or policies on residential amenity – in particular to deal with local concerns regarding overlooking and overbearing on infill plots and with large extensions to existing properties.
4. We hope to have the bulk of the work on the Draft Plan completed by the time of the next PC meeting at the end of the August.
5. The Draft Plan can then be passed via the Borough Council to the Statutory Consultees for comment.
