

NDP Report for March 2019

- NDP Report on Environment, Landscape and Biodiversity was signed off by the BC Planning Policy Team yesterday – indicating that they are sympathetic to the pressures that the Parish is facing.
- Now on the final set of revisions to the Draft Plan – reviewing the policies / main body of the text and will then be meeting the BC to review.
- The Plan has to be consistent with the adopted version of the Local Plan ie The Core Strategy and the SADMP – but it makes sense to check for consistency with the new version of the (Draft) Local Plan. This is currently out to consultation - so we will also be doing that over the next couple of weeks.
- The NDP development boundary has already been taken forward into the LDP and was displayed on one of the exhibits used in the consultation that took place in Hunstanton last week.
- Where an NDP boundary is adopted in this way the BC is now proposing that villages will not be subject to the policy which will allow development to take place beyond the development boundary.
- We will need to re-pay some unused grant money this month but will probably make one last claim to cover some help from Richard High and the remaining consultation events.

Draft LDP Consultation runs from 4 March 2019 until 15 April 2019.
