

Neighbourhood Plan Update – July 2019

1. The Neighbourhood Plan is now on consultation until 7 August
2. The complete Draft Plan (3 parts:A-C) is available on the website

3. Reference copies of the full printed Plan have been deposited in Hunstanton Library and the Church. Loan copies available on request from Christina.
4. Notices have been posted on the 3 x Parish Noticeboards, distributed via VIN and also the Press (Lynn News)
5. 400 leaflets have been distributed to households, caravan sites, businesses and local organisations along with LINK Magazine - with help from the Link delivery team and Councillors
6. Responses are now trickling in – mainly from public authorities and land owners. All will need to be analysed and incorporated into a consultation document together with our responses. We intend to take account of all responses so please do find time to feed back your thoughts.
7. A Drop-In session with a poster display has been arranged for next Saturday (20 July) afternoon in the Village Hall from 2 – 6.30 pm – this is last chance to comment on the Plan before it is formally submitted to BCKL&WN so please encourage parishioners to come along and to leave their comments on the forms provided! There will be tea and cakes on sale from 2 – 5.30pm – in aid of the Astro Brain Tumour Charity.
8. **All of the policies and maps** will be displayed at the exhibition and the NDP Team and Parish Councillors will be on hand to deal with queries.
9. If anyone is known to have difficulties in getting along – please do contact Christina who will arrange assistance
10. Budget – we are expecting to be slightly over-budget on printing / exhibition costs but under-budget on consultancy support.
